

Glyphosate Report: Legend for Location Identifiers

ADCX H #: Mile post number along the Adirondack Railroad Corridor. Mile posts are written to the hundredths of a mile (e.g., ADCX H29.12-H33.84).

BIN #: Bridge Identification Number assigned to New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) managed bridges.

EB/WB/SB/NB: Denote direction of travel - East Bound/West Bound/ South Bound/North Bound.

MM: Mile Markers – Signs placed along New York Thruway Authority (NYTA) managed roadways. MM's are placed every tenth of a mile on both sides of the road.

NYTA locations are written as:

- Thruway interstate number, direction, and MM range
 - Example: I-87 NB MM 0.48-2.7

RM: Reference Markers – Signs that serve as location references placed along NYSDOT managed roadways. RM's are placed every tenth mile on both sides of the road and contain three lines of location specific information. The first line denotes the route number, the second line describes the NYSDOT regional location, and the third line locates the specific portion of the route within the county.

NYSDOT reference markers are written as:

- RM, three lines of reference marker including mile range, direction
 - Example: RM 14 6302 1074 to 1085 EB

SF: State Forest

WMA/WMU: Wildlife Management Area/Unit

New York Power Authority (NYPA) Power Line Designations Legend

Locations are written as:

- 2 road names crossing the right-of-way, powerline designation (legend below) tower number (first number is mile number from the source/ second number is tower number within that mile)
 - Example: Massena-Helena Rd to S. Raquette St, Structure MSC-01/01

MSC	Massena to Chateauguay

S1A2A-EIS	Seaway 1A/2A lines to Eisenhower
UCC	Utica to Coopers Corners
UE2	Utica to Edic (2 line)
