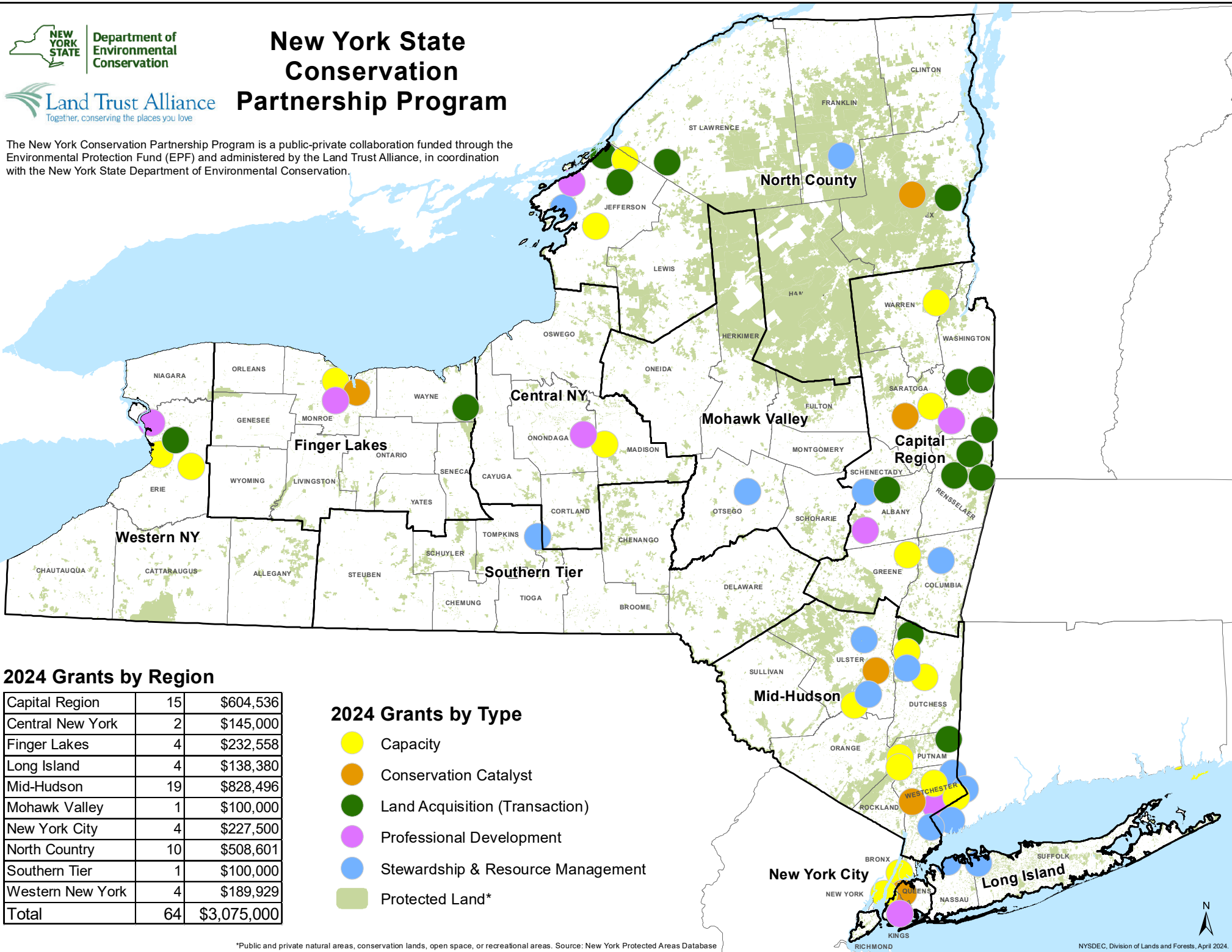


# New York State Conservation Partnership Program
