

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

NON-AGRICULTURAL NONPOINT SOURCE PLANNING AND MS4 MAPPING GRANT (NPG)

Can an applicant submit multiple applications to examine different components of the same project site?

An applicant may submit up to five applications for components of a comprehensive study, but only one practice (grant category) can be included per application.

For the Comprehensive Stream Corridor Assessment Study Outline, do the parameters listed under Section IV, items 2-6 need to be collected for the entire length of stream within the HUC 12 boundary, or is it acceptable to collect that information for priority areas identified within the project area? Section IV, items 2-6 need to be collected for the entire length of stream, not just the priority areas.

Does the winter road maintenance plan need to be signed by a highway professional or does it need to be stamped by an engineer?

An engineering stamp is not required if the report was not prepared by an engineer. A signature from a highway professional is sufficient.

What is the definition of an MS4 collaborative? Can municipalities come together informally to apply collaboratively or is more formal action required?

The MS4 mapping grant application does not require formal action or formal documentation (like a resolution) be provided to demonstrate an MS4 collaborative. A municipality can apply on behalf of other municipalities and would be eligible to receive up to \$60,000 per municipality, up to \$400,000 total. All participating municipalities will need to be identified in the Town's application.
